
On the eve of May Day

The lives of Reza Shahabi, his family, as well as other labor activists are in danger!

Stop threats and harassment of the labor activists and their families!

The criminal capitalist regime of Iran has hidden its fear and horror, during its disgraceful life with harassment, arrest, torture and execution.

The capitalist government with its Islamic parliament, judicial and military apparatus, lumpen, and mobsters, tried all different tricks in the book, to threaten and disrupt the workers' movements and programs, protests, strikes, gatherings, and organizations of the workers and toilers, especially on the eve of May Day. But, the tide has changed a long time ago, and by its speedy wave, will overthrow its entire existence.



Every year, on the eve of May Day, the henchmen of this infamous regime, bring out their fear and fright and try to harass, persecute, summoned and arrest the labor activists that may be able to disrupt the organization of May Day- International workers' Day, but each year they have been more unsuccessful and have faced embarrassment more than ever.

The working class and toilers are a force of millions, that every day becomes stronger, more organized and more united. The train that has been set in motion is on its way, and the ruling class cannot stop this runaway train, which cannot be a barrier to this great social movement.

The Tehran and Suburbs Bus Company Workers' Syndicate, in a statement, has announced that Reza Shahabi, a dismissed worker and a member of Wahed Company and his family have been threatened with death by mobsters and lumpen of the Islamic Republic.

Also, The Free Trade Union of Iran has reported that Jafar Azimzadeh and Parvin Mohammadi have been threatened by telephone.

Ali Nejati, this retired and ill worker, has been summoned again for 5 years imprisonment, which has been cancelled.

Mahmoud Salehi and other labor activists of Kurdistan are summoned repeatedly and interrogated, and ... what else is it but the fear of the rising masses to drive the ruling class so madly, to suppress, summon and take the labor activists to prison and even they have been publicly threatened with death?!

The shameful and bloody records of this inhuman regime and its henchmen indicate that the ruling class and its security apparatus will commit any crime to save their rotten regime. Therefore, we must not



ignore these ominous threats to the lives of our loved ones, comrades and co-worker activists, and we should confront those responsible for death threats quickly and decisively.

Solidarity Committees With Iranian Workers Movement-abroad, whilst condemning these state atrocities by its thugs, call on the international labor organizations and labor advocates to support the Iranian labor activists, and to expose the capitalist Islamic Republic in Iran, and take urgent actions to prevent these potential dangers and to maintain safety, for the lives of the labor activists in Iran.

***Closing declaration of the first nationwide gathering of the retirees
and the pensioners of the Social Security Organization***

Friends and dear retirees and pensioners, survivors and disabled:

The just demands of the retirees of the SSO (Social Security Organization) which were launched since 2020 have now entered a new phase and will continue in 2021 as well. We demand the restoration of our rights according to the law and warn the SSO to stop ignoring the law and meet our lawful demands.

Here **we put forth our demands in two groups:**

- □ First - the retirees' legal demands
- □ Second- structural changes in SSO and cutting off the government access to SSO and SS Fund

▪ □ **Legal demands**

1 - Execution of equalization of the retirees of 2021 pension based on the budget approved by the parliament at the beginning of the year.

2 - According to the article 54 of the Social Security Law, the SSO is responsible for the total healthcare of the subscribed retirees and we demand that this law to be put into action.

3 - Removal of the phrase "ex gratia records" and its replacement by "years of hardship and unhealthy environment entitlement".

4 - Revival and return of 85 medicine items.

5 - Annual increase of salaries/wages based on articles 96 and 111 from March 2021

6 - Payment of special amounts regarding the war zones of the border provinces to the retirees who were employed in these zones during the war.

7 - Annual increase of salaries/wages based on article 96 and based on declared rate of inflation by the Central Bank regardless the level of these salaries/wages. SSO is responsible for increase of the salaries/wages of the retirees, whose number has reached ten millions now, to compensate for the inflation and to take into the consideration the poverty line.

8 - Cancellation of two percent deduction from the retiree's salaries/wages for their healthcare benefits.

▪ □ **Structural change in Social Security Organization**

1 - The capital of the companies under "SHASTA" (Investment Company of Social Security) which belongs to workers and retirees should be given to them as shares.

2 - Repeal of the internal article 69 of SSO and the increase of the coverage to the whole organization and removal of the discrimination among associates and non-associates.

At the end we emphasize that we, the retirees of the Social Security, will be relentless in achieving our demands and will not compromise with anyone.

The promises that Mr. Salari has given about the minimum payment for the retirees does not meet our demands considering the present inflation and, as we have declared many times, our salaries/wages should be adjusted to inflation. How can we take care of the families' costs of living with this level of salaries/wages when the poverty line is 10 million Touman (\$US400.00)?

of the workers of the world*

Joint statement of 15 organization including: syndicates and other independent labor organizations, teachers trade associations, independent retirees organizations and women rights advocate organizations for May First, International labor day.

This year we are celebrating May First, the day of solidarity of the workers of the world, when the world health crisis has affected the lives of many workers.

Global Corona contagion (Covid -19) along with the economic crisis, have put the workers and wage earners, and small business men in a very hard situation. In Iran because of mismanagement of the government and state the situation is worse than any other places.



Lack of an effective health system and not having necessary quarantines along with funding people's lives from the state has caused the livelihood crisis among the poor people. In spite of workers demand for immediate and free vaccination, people of power deliberately postpone this and with making crisis try to secure

the profits of some special group in the ruling class. In doing that they insist on producing the domestic vaccines and making the private sector involved.

This, in turn, has engulfed large segments of the population; especially the middle classes of society, in increasing poverty and the growing number of them have been marginalized. Meanwhile, the situation of women workers and toilers is the most deplorable.

According to existing statistics, 70 percent of women workers have been fired and out of work under the pretext of the Corona virus Pandemic. In the case of livelihoods, this instability and the process of systematic destitution of wage-earners, with maximum discrimination, has, above all, manifested itself in the livelihoods of women which low employment rights, being at the forefront of expulsion and unemployment and isolating female workers are among the consequence, for its part, inflicted another great wound on the body of Iran's working class. Meanwhile, the situation of women who work at home and have lost their income is the worst. Both gender discrimination and unemployment and bankruptcy have put additional pressure on this part of Iran's workforce.

Nevertheless, workers in Iran and their allies have been actively fighting and pursuing tirelessly in the past year when the balance of power has not benefited them and labor activists and other social movements were under multi-layered and systematic repression.



Workers and wage earners in different sectors of the economy from major industries such as petrochemicals, Hepco, Azarab, Haft Tappeh sugarcane, Tehran Bus Company, Khuzestan Steel Co. and



to teachers, retirees, students and women, have advanced their struggles in various ways and have demonstrated their opposition to the harsh and neoliberal policies of the state and government. In the meantime, we can particularly mention the tireless struggles of Haft Tappeh workers, who have raised important and basic issues such as privatization, large embezzlement of shareholders and the main owners of Haft Tappeh at the community level and, in contrast, have spoken of the role of the worker in decision-making and council administration.

Campaigns supported by their allies around the world. To the extent that we have repeatedly witnessed statements and campaigns supporting workers, trade unions in far and near the world.

In the face of these national and international solidarities, pro-capitalist tendencies suggest and propose all kinds of plans and alternatives to exiting the crisis one after the other. Every day a new trick is presented. But Iran's workers have experienced that the solution to these problems and the release of these problems cannot be raised by those who themselves play a leading role in creating them under this or that name. Workers are no longer deceived by lies, including election promises and promises that are repeated every few years.

The solution is also not derived from falling in love with the great world powers (Whatever their colours and kind) and the game of politics between them. Such attachments to powers in political geography – both global and regional – are in fact the pawning and giving of the hardworking masses and the paving road for the dominators to exploit the country's resources, as well as the decisive influence of foreigners in macroeconomic, political, and strategic decision-making.

The question of world hegemonic powers has never been and is never the protection of the interests of the working class and the working masses anywhere in the world. The solution in Iran, such as the class struggle in other parts of the world, is only from class unity and solidarity between the workers themselves and their linkage and cooperation with others by forming and maintaining their independent ranks, Iran's workers and wage earners should not allow the abuse of non-workers and their deceptive and risky schemes in defense of capitalism, which have no sign of social justice and acceptance of the role of workers in the management of society.

The fact is that we workers are facing a dispersal problem in the present situation, and this is a warning that despite the continuation of work and sacrifice in the struggle and despite the declaration of open and genuine solidarity and empathy among the activists of social movements, without a serious and organized and nationwide cooperation among all workers and toilers, we will not be able to confront anti-worker policies and change the existing conditions.

We have experienced many times how, in the absence of independent labor organizations and representatives, the issue of determining wages has at least become ridiculously repetitive and dismal. While the poverty line for an Iranian household living in major cities should be at least 12 million Toumans (\$US480.00), and even the affiliated and governmental organizations such as The Worker's House (khane Kargar) speaks from 8 to 9 million Touman (\$US320.00-360.00), refused to accept the estimated household basket cost of 8 million and 200,000 Touman (\$US328.00), and did not even pay attention to the moans and laments of representatives of accepted and affiliated organizations.

Now, the lack of organization within the labor units and the regional and national organizations of workers has manifested itself more strongly than ever before and calls for a tireless struggle to create them. Without such a coherent and nationwide organization, the effects of the presence and struggle of workers would not be very significant and the results would be minimal, unsupported and fragile. In the current situation, it is more necessary to establish a cooperation council between different sectors of workers, employees and wage earners, teachers, retirees, women, students and the unemployed. This is not a duty among other duties, but the main circle of organizing work in society and among workers and toilers.



Without coordination and going towards the establishment of cooperative and nationwide institutions to jointly guide the movements of demands, the power of these courageous and consistent protest movements demands are wasted, and it paved the way to suppress them.

Efforts to converge between sporadic struggles and the expansion of solidarity in the year ahead will be an urgent and vital necessity.

Strikes, the creation of free and independent labor organizations, are the indisputable right of The Workers of Iran!

The release of the workers will only be possible by the workers themselves!

Reza Shahabi and his family are in danger of death

Open letter of 28.04.2021 from the trade union for the employees of bus companies in Tehran and the surrounding area

According to information on the Instagram page of Mr. Reza Shahabi, a respected member of the bus companies union in Tehran and the surrounding area, Mr Shahabi and his family were threatened with death. The union expresses deep concern about the threat to the life of Reza Shahabi and his family and calls for a swift and effective judicial investigation into the danger to life in which this respected worker now hangs. The following is his open letter to the Iranian judiciary:

"Good morning! I, Reza Shahabi, a sacked worker of the Tehran bus company, was elected a member of this union in accordance with the legally recognized guidelines of the union 1384/2005 and in this function I exercised my rights and those of my colleagues.



I was jailed for a long time for this completely legal and civil conduct for defamation after being arrested while working at the wheel of my bus. In 1389/2010 I was released from prison. But the bus company still does not allow me to resume my work. To my astonishment and horror, we, my family and I, have recently even been threatened with death. For some time now, an unknown person has been sending me



and my wife threatening messages via WhatsApp and SMS with two different numbers. At first I didn't care and didn't take the news seriously until two days ago the unknown person sent a few messages to my wife threatening to kill my wife, me, my son and my daughter. After these events, two motorcyclists attacked and beat my nephew in Jeihun Street last night, so my nephew was in shock. Then they took him to some neighboring streets under further threats. He twisted his arm, beat him and said: "Tell your uncle that he will pay a high price for what he does. Now we are not doing anything to you, but go to your uncle and tell him to be careful and stop doing what he is doing at the moment, otherwise we will come back and take both his son and his daughter with us and we will beat him so much that no one will recognize him any more." Since then, my family has been very concerned and, knowing none of these perpetrators, in order to be able to officially file criminal charges and to be able to prosecute these acts of violence, I fear that my life and that of my family is in great danger as a result of the threats. **I am very concerned for our lives because of the serious threat to me and my family from the unknown.**

As a worker and citizen of this country, I expect the judiciary, security and law enforcement agencies to take serious action to avert the threat to my life and the lives of my family members."

National Confederation of Alqa Cartel Syndicate and a Romanian Human Rights Association support Iranian workers on the occasi Dorr TV Global Network on TV on of International Workers' Day.

The National Confederation of The Alqa Cartel Syndicate and the Human Rights Association for the Protection of Refugees (AIHRD) from Romania on Friday, May 30, issued statements on the occasion of International Workers' Day saying: Violations of the human rights of the Iranian people and systematic violations of the basic rights of workers in Iran continue. The living conditions of disadvantaged toilers, especially workers, are already very difficult, with millions of people living below the poverty line.

The most important manufacturing and economic institutions in which workers are employed are in the hands of the IRGC or its private organs and agents, which exert maximum pressure and repression on the workers. **This is in a situation where many workers have not been paid for months or years. The situation of workers is getting worse every day, and poverty, unemployment and inflation are very severe.**

Over the past year, thousands of workers at manufacturing and industrial plants in different cities of Iran have gone on strike to protest against unpaid basic wages and no other premiums or benefits.

International labor conventions, of which Iran is a member state, are violated by the regime and the regime does not recognize the rights and freedoms of trade unions.

On the eve of International Workers' Day, in solidarity with Iranian workers, we support their protests and strikes in Iran to achieve their basic rights.

Demanding the release and freedom of all syndicate activists and political prisoners in Iran

The bulletin press release of the left party of Germany for the freedom of all syndicate activists and all of the political prisoners in Iran.

‘Wolf Galret’ the member of the executive administration of the leftist party of Germany explains the conditions of the syndicate activists:

The members of syndicates, journalists and political activists are always arrested and imprisoned. The economic crises in Iran because of the pandemic, internal corruption and sanctions are worse than ever before. The protests and the strikes by the workers in Iran is met by government’s aggression. It has been years that the government replies with heavy aggression to the workers strikes and protests. The union activists are imprisoned in non-humanitarian conditions; as an example the cases of ‘Esmail Bakhshi.’ ‘Mehrane Raoof.’ ‘Reza Shahbi’ and ‘Sepideh Ghalian’ whom are ‘human rights’ and ‘journalists’ activists fighting for the workers’ rights.

First of May, the international workers movement, is not just for higher wages and better working conditions; rather this an international movement in the world stage, for the right of free speech and the right of creating unions. The left party of Germany condemns the suppression of the workers and activists of the worker’s syndicate, human rights activists, and journalists and demands the release from jail and the subsequent freedom of all the political activists imprisoned.



We approve of the reopening and continued political discussion of the ‘JCPOA’. and the subsequent removal of the sanctions because another contestation will only bolster the hardliners and extremists and prevent the incoming of ‘white goods’ plus ‘medicine’ for the people. But the problem of the human rights must be remembered and not be forgotten and be overshadowed for geopolitical and economic reasons.

The committee for the defense of the Iranian political prisoners-Berlin, this year also the addressing around the workers movement struggle and continuous protests of the ‘Haft-Tapeh workers’ and other centers of production and explaining the conditions of suppression and and the conditions of the imprisoned workers for the unions and the leftist party has attracted support for these struggles.
